

What to expect during your power standing evaluation

Who will be there?



Occupational or Physical therapist



Assistive Technology Provider



Manufacturer representative



Other individuals as needed (e.g., family, caregiver, case manager)

What will they ask?



How will your daily activities and life roles be positively impacted by power standing?

For example, self-care, home management, school and/or work participation

What health benefits are you hoping to gain from power standing?

For example, pressure management, bowel and bladder function, spasticity reduction

What happens during the evaluation?



Measurements

The ATP or therapist will take measurements of your hips, legs, and upper body



Assessment of your current mobility system

How it fits and works for you and any necessary changes to consider



Trial of the power standing wheelchair

Going from sitting to standing, stand and drive functionality, and overall base performance

Team may recommend completion of the **Standing Trial Log** to aid in the justification and funding process

What happens after the evaluation?

Your team will:



Review funding, including insurance coverage or other alternative options



Schedule a home visit to confirm functionality of the wheelchair and standing within the home environment



Provide estimated timeline for completion of funding process and receiving your equipment



Schedule the equipment delivery once your power standing wheelchair arrives
